BUREAU CIRCULAR NO. 727

To All Members of the Bureau:

Re: **MANUAL REVISIONS**
CODE 969, AMUSEMENT - OUTDOOR
EFFECTIVE JUNE 1, 2000

The Bureau has filed and the Insurance Commissioner has approved Manual revisions to Section 5 to become effective as of **12:01 a.m., June 1, 2000** with respect to new and renewal business only. These revisions result from a Bureau study undertaken concurrent with a study of that same classification in Pennsylvania, which was initiated to review the feasibility of creating new, separate classifications for specific types of outdoor amusements or reassigning specific types of businesses to another Bureau class. The Delaware study found the scope of Code 969 to be sound and with no need of revision. However, three Underwriting Guide revisions were recommended, two of which are wording changes to avoid potential misinterpretation. The third change is the deletion of "Ski Tow Operation," there being no need for such an entry given that Delaware is a coastal plain state with its highest point above sea level being 440 feet, with no terrain for alpine or downhill skiing, the type that includes ski tow operations.

The enabling Manual revisions to Section 5 are shown below with deleted wording bracketed and new wording underlined:
