RE: DCRB Filing No. 2404 - Proposed Effective December 1, 2024 Manual Housekeeping Revisions to Section 2 of the Basic Manual

Dear Commissioner Navarro and Deputy Commissioner Merced:

On behalf of the members of the Delaware Compensation Rating Bureau, Inc. (DCRB), we hereby submit this filing for housekeeping revisions to the DCRB Workers' Compensation Manual of Rules, Classifications and Rating Values for Workers' Compensation and Employers Liability Insurance (Basic Manual). These revisions are proposed for policies effective at 12:01 a.m., December 1, 2024, or later. This proposed effective date is intended to coincide with the implementation of changes concurrent with DCRB's annual comprehensive residual market rate and voluntary market loss cost filing, which will be separately filed with the Department of Insurance for policies effective at 12:01 a.m., December 1, 2024, and later. This coordination consolidates necessary changes that our members and other constituents must make to policies, forms, and systems so that they occur only once annually. The proposed Basic Manual language housekeeping revisions are intended to assist in the administration of the DCRB's uniform classification plan and do not revise the scope of any classification. These proposals will not impact any classification's residual market rate or loss cost value or any employer's workers' compensation classification assignment.

Details of these proposals are provided in DCRB's June 5, 2024, staff memorandum, which is included in this filing. The DCRB Classification and Rating Committee (Committee) reviewed the memorandum and proposals at the Committee's June 5, 2024, meeting. The Committee raised no objections to the proposed Basic Manual language housekeeping revisions following that review.

The proposed Basic Manual language housekeeping revisions are summarized below:

- Section 2 Revisions to 6 classification descriptions for clarity.
- Underwriting Guide Addition of 5 new entries, revision to 5 existing entries, and deletion of 3 entries.
- General Auditing & Classification Information Section revision to the "Temporary Staffing Contractor" entry for clarity.

Thank you in advance for your review and attention to this filing. The DCRB will be pleased to answer any questions you or the Department of Insurance staff may have regarding these proposals.
